

Épée Hitmate™

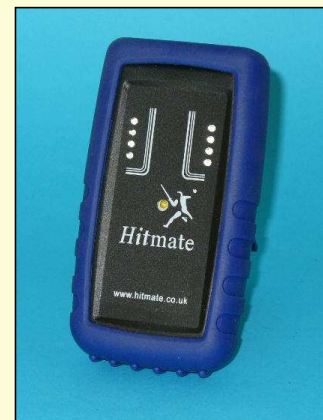
The smallest, lightest scoring system for épée fencing!

Discover wireless fencing for yourself, and experience the benefits in training and practice. Enjoy the freedom of using this simple lightweight equipment in any environment.

When a fencer scores a hit, the Hitmate Console flashes red or green lights and sounds an audible tone for 2 seconds.

The Console includes a support for floor standing within sight of both players and has an impact resistant cover for protection.

It is powered by a 9 volt alkaline battery and requires no wires or cables connected to it.



There are two fencers' units: Red and Green. Each one connects through a standard body wire to any electric épée.

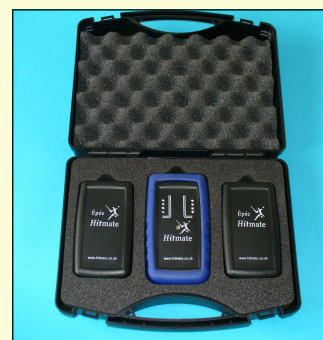
When a hit is made, the unit sends a radio signal to the console, resulting in a Red or Green score display. A lockout period of two seconds automatically follows any hit. The console indicates first or simultaneous hits according to FIE timing rules.

If a fencer makes a hit to the opponent's guard, no score is registered at the console and there is no lockout.

The three units (Red, Green and Console) fit into a handy, tough carry-case with a hinged lid.

The case also provides storage for three spare batteries. Battery life is up to 100 hours operation. All units switch themselves off after 30 minutes inactivity to conserve battery power.

Épée Hitmate is a compact and lightweight wireless scoring system ideal for clubs, coaches and all practice venues.
